

LAND TRANSACTIONS BY ABEL HAZELRIGG, 1763 & 1764

5 November 1763. Abel Hazelrigg & Mary his wife of County of Prince William, Parish of Dettenger, and James Rey of same county and parish. Deed to a certain tract of land being and lying in ye county and parish aforesaid. Containing one hundred acres of land, being part of a larger tract of land left by will to the aforesaid Hazelrigg by his deceased father Richard Hazelrigg and bounded as followeth, viz: Beginning at a corner tree of Thomas Bland's and running from thence a strait course to ye head of Champo branch thence Running down ye branch to ye white oak branch thence running down the said white oak branch to Champo branch to the line of Hornsley thence running with Hornsley's line to ye beginning. Purchase twenty pounds. One pound and sixpence being received and the other part to be paid by the said Rey the 20 Dec. in the year 1764.

18 April 1764. Abel Hazelrigg & Mary, John Hazelrigg and Elizabeth, James Rey and Sarah his wife to Benjamin King. Whereas Richard Hazelrigg and William Williams by deeds of lease and release bearing date the 21st and 22nd days of November, 1742, purchased in jointenancy five hundred and forty seven acres of land more or less from George Byrne deceased and Lydia his wife lying and being in the parish & county aforesaid upon the Branches of Occoquan and by a division line being made between them the said Richard Hazelrigg and William Williams the said Hazelrigg's part of the said land was allotted him on the east end thereof and beginning for the same at a red oak in or near the line of William Bland and extending thence north eight degrees East 180 poles to several red oaks thence North 100 poles to the line of Brown's heirs including 340 acres Relation being to the deeds given to the said Richard Hazelrigg & William Williams for the course of the whole tract from the said George Byrne's and Lydia his wife as also the part possessed by the said William Williams which deeds are remaining of record in the said county of Prince William. And the said Richard Hazelrigg by his last will and testament among other things did give and Devise all his land to his son Abel Hazelrigg first party to these presents and whereas the said Abel Hazelrigg and Mary his wife .....[much legal wording]. This land formerly sold to James Rey is now being sold to Benjamin King by Abel & Mary, John & Elizabeth, James Rey & Sarah. Also includes all of land given and devised by Richard Hazelrigg containing in the whole 210 acres and all houses, buildings, orchards, etc.
