The foregoing information comes from a family tree posted on Ancestry.com and from US census enumerations (but lately augmented; see below). In addition, the 1900 census has Polly A Hazelrigg (b. Feb 1849 KY, widow) as head of household consisting also of children James, Mary, Amanda Hazelrigg, and Thomas and Allie (Hazelrigg) Dodd, in Fox Township, Lincoln County, OK; their neighbor was William E Mayfield (b. Oct 1868 TX), his wife Emma, and their two sons. The 1910 census has Thomas and Allie Dodd, plus children Ira, Herman, and Annie, in El Paso, TX. The 1920 census of Sand Springs, Tulsa County, OK, reports Thomas and Allie, plus six children; they shared a rental duplex with James Hazelrigg (36, IN, widowed) and his children Dorothy, Edith, Lloyd, and Arthur. Sometimes James was listed as James C Hazelrigg. The one time his middle name was given in full it was Kerges. This was by his own hand, on his military registration in 1918, which also gives his residence as Sand Springs, his birth date as 28 Mar 1882, his wife as Letha, and his work as a laborer at an oil company. The 1900 census of OK (Choctaw Nation, Indian Territory) lists a William Karges (52 KY) and his wife M A Karges (48 IN), but perhaps the coincidence of names is not relevant here. It appears that Mary Ann (Polly) Reeder and her first husband (Fnu Mayfield) migrated from KY to TX by 1875. Then Mary Ann married Henry E Dooly or Dooley. (This man has not been located in any census or other official record, but the family tree referred to above gives an exact birth date, which suggests a family record of some sort.) The Dooly union was short-lived; by 1880 Mary Ann was married to Fnu Hazelrigg and living in Indian Territory (i.e., OK). According to the 1900 census of Fox Township, Lincoln County, OK, Polly A Hazelrigg (b. Feb 1849 KY) was widowed, a farmer, had borne seven children of whom seven survived (thus, one is missing from the outline above). In 1910 she was living with son James, his wife Letha, their daughter Dorothy, and Josiah Mayfield (35 TX), listed as James' brother, in Carter County, OK. So, *the big question*, who was the Hazelrigg man who married Mary ("Polly") Ann Reeder? The answer is still "Unknown."

Update: No longer "Unknown," thanks to some superb sleuthing by Donna Miller and Kathleen Farrar, descendants of Mary Ann Reeder. Because of the paucity of records for Oklahoma during the relevant period, a document proving the connection has not been and perhaps will never be found, but with high probability we can say that Mary Ann Reeder's third husband was Henry⁸ Clay Hazelrigg, second son of John⁷ Franklin and Lucretia (Morgan) Hazelrigg (see page 265, line -21). Lucretia died soon after the birth of Henry, who was then "taken in" by Lucretia's sister, Almira H (Morgan) Self, wife of Presley Hardin Self. After Almira's death, Presley and his second wife Catherine (Peery) Self, along with Henry Clay Hazelrigg, moved to St Marysville Township, Miami County, KS, where they farmed 40 acres. Henry appears in their household in the 1870 federal census. In the 1875 KS state census (and again in the 1885 census) Presley and Catherine are alone; no sign of Henry. One explanation is death or migration. However, Donna and Kathleen found rejected applications by Mary Ann (Reeder) Hazelrigg, and separately by six of her children, in the Guion Miller Roll of the Eastern Cherokee, and these record the name of the husband/father as "Henry Hazelrigg." No proof that these men named "Henry Hazelrigg" are one and the same; but it is highly probable. Many thanks to Donna and Kathleen, who also supplied some descendant information, which has been interpolated above and which will be incorporated in a third edition of the book (if and when).

The earliest record yet found for Jacob (and three sons, plus his mother-in-law, Charity Horalson or Harolson) is the 1880 federal enumeration, Frick's Gap, Walker County, GA: Jacob's household is enumerated immediately after that of Alexander Washington Coulter, his wife Margaret, and some of their children. Note that A W Coulter was brother of Delilah Jane Coulter who married Thomas Jefferson Haslerig (see pages 386-87, 418, 491). Jacob had very likely been born into slavery on the A W Coulter plantation. His occupation in 1880 was "laborer," and given the proximity of households his labor was probably supplied to A W Coulter. The relationship of Jacob to William and Ann Haslerig, from whom descended many households of Walker County, GA, and beyond (see pages 490ff), has not been determined, but it appears that Jacob was not one of their sons. According to the census report, Jacob's father and mother were both born in NC, as was William, but Jacob does not appear in the enumeration of William and Ann's household, and unless Jacob was a twin there is not calendar space among Ann's known pregnancies. Given Jacob's birth year, it seems likely he had one or more children prior to son Clinton.

Note: James Haslerig (b. 15 Jul 1908; d. Aug 1982 Knoxville, TN; OASI issued KY) perhaps belongs to that lineage, perhaps a son of Clinton and Victoria.
